We also aid in the development of a plan for a better life, because The Christian Sharing Center has trained client service managers who lead people from "those-in-need" to "those-who-succeed". Making every penny count, 90% of every dollar goes to serving over 20,000 people annually through our programs.

Donated goods and clothing support those in need.

- Over \$600,000 worth of clothing, household goods and furniture is given to clients annually.
- Generating 30% of our income, the Thrift Store and Boutique directly contribute to funding client programs.
- Shop or donate with us Monday - Saturday – 9:30am - 5pm



Provides healthy meal choices for families and individuals.

- Distributes over 35,000 bags of food valued at almost \$1 million annually.
- Provides families and the homeless with food bags at Easter, Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- Allows clients to select items based upon their health restrictions, cultural traditions and family needs.
- Designated by Seminole County as a first responder for food distribution in times of declared disaster.
- Assistance with essential resources offered Monday - Friday – 9:00am - 12:00pm



A place where homeless families, children and adults can be renewed.

- Showers and personal toiletry bags.
- Professional haircuts and shaves.
- Laundered clothing by volunteers.
- Computer and cell charging stations for email, job searches or homework.
- Approximately 3,000 homeless visitors served annually.



Each year, over 1,200 children blessed with new shoes to ensure healthy feet.

- Shoe gift card program provides new shoes for children three times per year.
