




Summary of BMI Data from Seminole Co. School Health Screenings (2006–2014)

The following tables and charts summarize trends and compare results from Growth and Development/ BMI screenings conducted in Seminole County Public Schools with comparable aggregate data from the state. The data was obtained from the *Summary of School Health Services*, compiled by the School Health Program at the Florida Department of Health. Data represents results from students screened in grades 1st, 3rd, 6th, in accordance with School Health Program guidelines. Percentages are calculated based on Department of Education enrollment numbers minus students enrolled in virtual, residential, jail school, etc.
