

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Programs & Services

Dental Care

(407) 665-3604

The Dental Care Program provides services to children and limited urgent services for adults. Services may include exams, x-rays, cleanings, sealants, fillings, extractions and more. Payment options include Medicaid and self pay.

Environmental Health

County-wide services designed to educate, regulate and inspect facilities and operations such as septic system placement, public swimming pool regulations and inspections of various institutional settings for cleanliness, safe food handling and disease control.

Immunizations/Vaccines (407) 665-3281

Child and adult immunizations such as hepatitis A and B, Tdap, polio, HIB, HPV, chickenpox, measles, meningitis and shot records, including Immunization Form 680.

Travel Shots

Provide vaccines required and recommended for foreign travel as well as information about food and water conditions for the business and pleasure traveler.

Flu and Pneumonia Shots

Flu vaccines are available seasonally; pneumonia vaccines are available year around.

Birth & Death Certificates (407) 665-3226

Birth Certificates issued after 1930 for the State of Florida are available. Death Certificates can be issued for deaths that occurred within a particular time frame. Please call to verify.

Office of Health Promotion and Education

Promotes and coordinates community engagement and partnerships to offer chronic disease prevention education and screenings, hosts health observance events and assesses community specific health needs. The OHPE manages the following programs and services for our employees and community:

Tobacco Prevention Program

Provides a comprehensive approach to prevent and reduce tobacco use, and prevent exposure to second hand smoke. Services include education and training. Also oversees a county-wide Students Working Against Tobacco (SWAT) Program.

Sexually Transmitted Diseases Confidential or anonymous HIV testing, diagnosis, treatment, and counseling for all STDs. Provides free condoms.

HIV/AIDS Services

HIV/AIDS education, medical and case management services, and drug assistance program for qualified individuals.

Teen Clinic

Provides sexual health and family planning education to teens. Provides services such as birth control methods, confidential pregnancy and STD and HIV testing just for teens.

Tuberculosis (TB) Program (407) 665-3243

Testing, diagnostic evaluations, treatment and follow-up for active TB disease and latent TB infection.

Epidemiology

Conducts disease surveillance and investigates occurrences of infectious diseases and conditions reported by physicians, hospitals and laboratories. Provides disease control education, consultation and intervention

Hepatitis Prevention Program (407) 665-3019

Provides counseling, education and testing for hepatitis A, B, and C. Vaccines for A and B are available for those at risk or who qualify.

Public Health Preparedness

Responsible for coordinating Seminole County's public health and medical preparedness and response to emergencies and disasters. This includes medical support to Special Needs Shelters and mass dispensing of antibiotics or vaccinations.

Women & Child Health Services

Provides a wide range of services to improve the health and well-being of women, infants, children and families.

Breast & Cervical Cancer Program (407) 665-3185

Offers free pap smears and mammograms for eligible women 50-64 years of age.

School Physicals

Physical examinations to meet the requirement for children enrolling in school.

Pregnancy Testing

(407) 665-3700 Pregnancy tests available: free for women ages 18 and younger, and for a fee for over 18 years old.

Family Planning Program

Counseling and birth control methods for men and women of child-bearing age.

WIC Program

(407) 665-3705

Services are offered to eligible pregnant and postpartum women, infants and children under the age of five. Participants receive a WIC EBT card to conveniently purchase specific nutritious foods to supplement their diets. Nutrition education and counseling as well as breastfeeding support services are available. WIC services are offered in both Sanford and Casselberry.
