

Programs & Services

Birth & Death Certificates (407) 665-3226

Birth Certificates issued after 1930 for the State of Florida are available. Death Certificates can be issued for deaths that occurred within a particular time frame. Please call to verify. *Certificate services also can be obtained in Casselberry at our office located at 132 Sausalito Boulevard, Casselberry, FL 32707.*

Dental Care (407) 665-3346

We provide dental care for children and adults including exams, xrays, cleanings, sealants, fillings, extractions and more. Limited urgent services available.

Environmental Health (407) 665-3604

County-wide services designed to educate, regulate and inspect facilities and operations such as septic system placement, public swimming pool regulation and inspections of various institutional settings for cleanliness, safe food handling and disease control.

Hepatitis Program (407) 665-3019

Provides counseling, education and testing for hepatitis A, B, and C. Vaccines for A and B are available for those at risk or who qualify.

Refugee Health Program (407) 665-3242

Refugee health assessments, immunizations & any necessary follow-up or referrals are provided within 90 days to eligible qualified clients.

School Health Services (407) 665-3430

A multi-faceted program serving public and private schools. Services include screening and monitoring of growth and development, dental, scoliosis, hearing & vision. Health Education Presentations. Teen Outreach Program offered.

Tobacco Prevention Program (407) 665-3454

Provides a comprehensive approach to prevent and reduce tobacco use, and prevent exposure to second hand smoke. Services include education and training. Also oversees a county-wide Students Working Against Tobacco (SWAT) Program.

Tuberculosis (TB) Program (407) 665-3243

Testing, diagnostic evaluations, treatment and follow-up for active TB disease and latent TB infection.

Almost all services are provided by appointment. We accept most health insurances, offer financial assistance and accept Visa, MasterCard and cash. Call the listed phone number for questions and to schedule your appointment.

Clinical & Nutritional Health Services

Breast & Cervical Cancer Screening (407) 665-3185

This program offers free pap smears and mammograms for eligible women 50–64 years of age.

Family Planning (407) 665-3700

Pregnancy planning, prevention including birth control for men and women, free condoms, and sterilization including tubal ligation and vasectomy both in coordination with local physicians.

Flu and Pneumonia Shots (407) 665-3700

Flu vaccines are available seasonally; pneumonia vaccines are available year around.

Healthy Start (407) 665-3278

Individualized social services and health care coordination for pregnant women and infants up to the age of three. Services include risk assessments, case management, childbirth classes, parenting education, smoking cessation support, and referrals for nutrition, counseling and community resources.

HIV/AIDS Testing, Prevention & Treatment (407) 665-3700

Provides HIV/AIDS education, medical and case management services; drug assistance program for qualified individuals.

Immunizations/Vaccines (407) 665-3700

Child and adult immunizations such as TD, polio, hepatitis A&B, Tdap, HPV, chicken pox, measles, and Immunization Form 680 are available.

Men's Health (407) 665-3700

Men are able to receive birth certificates, dental care, immunizations, family planning, STD and HIV/AIDS Testing Prevention and Treatment, and TB Screenings.

Pregnancy Testing (407) 665-3700

Pregnancy testing available.

School and College Physicals (407) 665-3700

Physical examinations to meet the requirement for children enrolling in school.

STD Testing, Prevention & Treatment (407) 665-3700

Provides confidential or anonymous HIV testing, diagnosis, treatment, and counseling for all STDs. Provides free condoms.

Teen Health (407) 665-3700

Provides sexual health and family planning education to teens. We also provide services such as free condoms, birth control methods, confidential pregnancy and STD testing and anonymous HIV testing just for teens.

Travel Vaccines (407) 665-3700

Provides vaccines required and recommended for foreign travel as well as information about food and water conditions for the business and pleasure traveler.

WIC (407) 665-3705

Services are provided for pregnant and nursing women, infants and children up to the age of five. Provides checks to purchase specific foods to supplement one's diet. Individual and group nutrition education counseling and breastfeeding support services are available. *WIC Services also offered in Casselberry at 132 Sausalito Boulevard, Casselberry, FL 32707*
