


## School Health Services

### School Health Facts

- + Our program serves 60 public schools in Seminole County.
- + \*\*For school year 2011-2012 in Seminole County Public Schools:
  - Over 13,300 students were screened for growth & development/BMI
  - About 4,800 students were screened for scoliosis
  - More than 12,800 students received dental health screenings
  - More than 17,700 students were screened for vision
  - Over 13,900 students received hearing screenings
- + Based on these screenings, more than 5,333 students were referred for further medical follow-up.
- + 72 private schools\* in Seminole County received health screening and education services through our program.
