School Health Services

Our School Health Program is pleased to offer preventative student health services to private schools! Some of our services are provided as mandated by statute while others are available upon school request.

School Entry Immunizations & Health Examination Records Review

-Florida statutes requires children who enter private or public school must have up-to-date immunizations and present a certified school entry examination form.

-Registered nurses from the Florida Department of Health in Seminole County visit each private school at the beginning of the school year to check records for all Kindergarteners, 7th graders and all new students to the state.

-All students must have a certificate showing a physical examination done within one year of the start of Kindergarten or within one year of entry into Florida schools.

Health Screenings

-Screenings are offered free of charge and are available upon request only for vision, hearing and/or scoliosis. Screenings are performed by school health nurses for the following grades:

**1st Grade: Vision & Hearing*

**3rd Grade: Vision Only*

**6th Grade: Vision, Hearing & Scoliosis*

-All Students must have signed consent from a parent or guardian to participate in the screening. A template consent form is available from our office, upon request.
